Formatting Requirements:

Font: Use Times New Roman, size 12.

Spacing: Abstracts should be double -spaced

Word Count: Your abstract should contain between 500-700 words. This limit includes all text,

excluding the title, author names, affiliations, and references.

Content Structure:

Title: Clearly and concisely indicate the topic of the abstract. Avoid using abbreviations in the title.

Introduction: Briefly describe the background of your research and its objectives.

Methods: Outline your methodology in a concise manner, providing enough detail for the reader to understand how the research was conducted.

Results: Present the key findings of your research. Use specific data and, if allowed, include essential figures or tables (In case of developing paper, state expected outcomes)

Conclusions: Summarize the main outcomes of your research and their implications. Highlight the significance of your findings in your field of study.
