

## Abstract submission Guidelines

### Formatting Requirements:

**Font:** Use Times New Roman, size 12.

**Spacing:** Abstracts should be double -spaced

**Word Count:** Your abstract should contain between 500-700 words. This limit includes all text, excluding the title, author names, affiliations, and references.

### Content Structure:

**Title:** Clearly and concisely indicate the topic of the abstract. Avoid using abbreviations in the title.

**Introduction:** Briefly describe the background of your research and its objectives.

**Methods:** Outline your methodology in a concise manner, providing enough detail for the reader to understand how the research was conducted.

**Results:** Present the key findings of your research. Use specific data and, if allowed, include essential figures or tables (In case of developing paper, state expected outcomes)

**Conclusions:** Summarize the main outcomes of your research and their implications. Highlight the significance of your findings in your field of study.
